Peterborough, ON, May 1, 2013 --- On Friday, May 3, 2013 at 1:00 pm, Community Living Peterborough will kick off their 60th celebration of Community Living Month in the courtyard of their head office at 223 Aylmer Street.

During the celebration, **Mayor Daryl Bennett** will declare May 2013 as Community Living Month throughout Peterborough with the reading of an official proclamation that urges all citizens of our community to celebrate the work of Community Living Peterborough. Board members, staff and people Community Living Peterborough supports, will also be in attendance.

Community Living Month is a province-wide initiative created to celebrate the philosophy and values of Community Living, which include building a community of inclusion, equality and respect that celebrates the contributions of all citizens.
